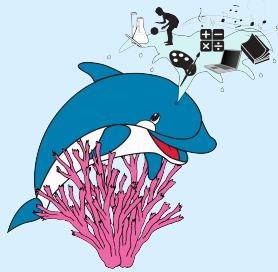


Please also be aware that Board of Education approved the Meal Charge policy which will go into effect in the 2017-2018 school year. More information about the new policy will follow during the summer.
